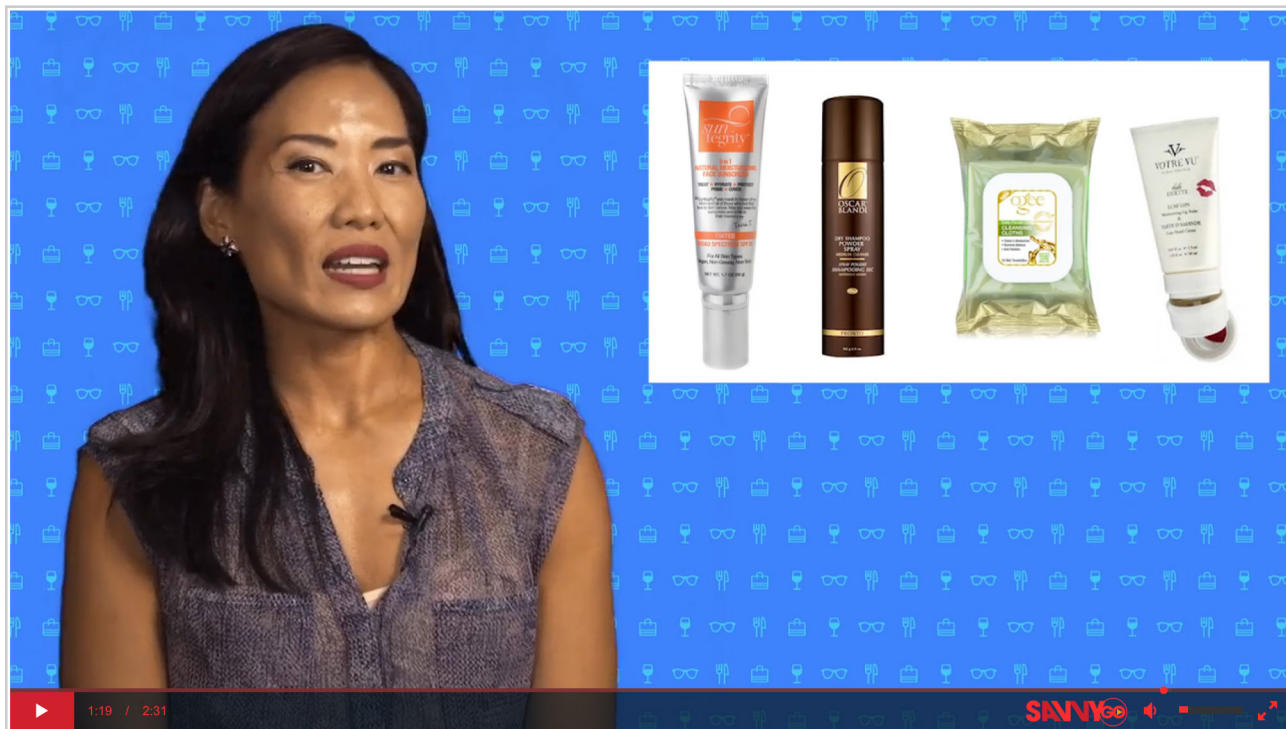


Best Beauty Products for Travel
