

Votre Vu's Sweep Eye Makeup Remover: Sweeping The Competition

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Could it be possible that I have finally discovered a non-oily eye makeup remover that actually takes off every trace of makeup? I think I have found that dream product in Votre Vu's Sweep Eye Makeup Remover which a lot of lash extension wearers have been praising since it does not erode the glue needed to keep false lashes intact. I really do not wear false lashes but am overjoyed to not have oily residue around my eyes because I like to reapply eye makeup mid-day. The oily residue in most eye makeup removal products requires users to rinse around the delicate eye tissue or use wipes!

This product is pricey at \$25 for four ounces but worth it (one bottle will last about three months used once a day). Sweep's "power ingredients" include Isotonic Solute, Rose Water, Boric Acid, and Bluet Water. The scent is sweet and fresh and you only need about a teaspoonful on one cotton pad to be able to completely remove eye makeup on both eyes. I take a flat cotton pad, apply some sweep and rub gently for ten to 15 seconds and even my tough eyeliner (which is topped with dark brown shadow) and waterproof mascara are removed. Some people prefer to use a Q-Tip to have more force and control when applying Sweep to their eye area.



Votre Vu products are made in France and sold only at private house parties. The company has really made a big splash on the luxury beauty product home sales industry and many of my beauty blogger friends confess to being "Votre Vixens," especially when it comes to their anti-aging products.
